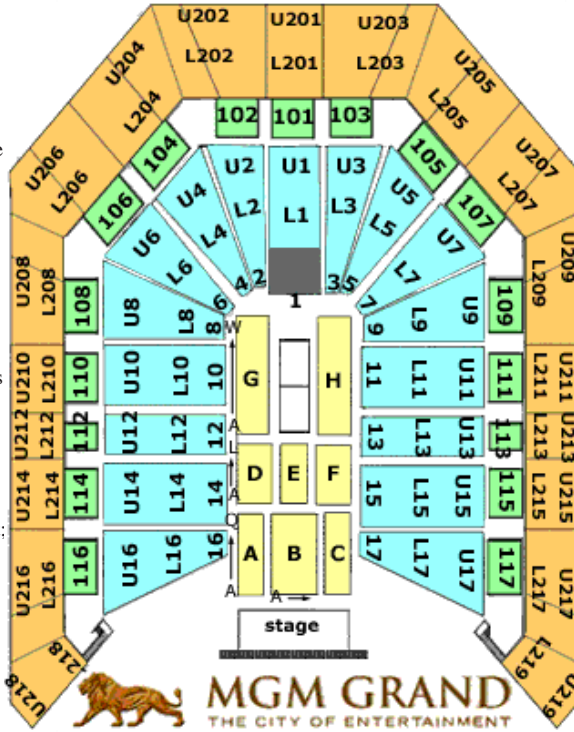

 With the show on a Sunday, traffic should be moving out of the city. The traffic fight begins once you exit the highway (I-15) but it's only 1/4 mile or so once you exit. It's a casino so security is very tight. Plentiful, free parking is behind the hotel. Coming into Las Vegas on I-15: Take the Tropicana Ave. exit; go E on Tropicana, & it's a very short drive to the MGM, which is on the left, at the corner of Tropicana & Las Vegas Blvd. (the Strip). From the S (from AZ) on U.S. 95: Take Tropicana Ave exit; go W on Tropicana for a few miles, & the MGM will be on the right. From the N on U.S. 95: From 95, take the exit for I-15 S (for L.A.); from I-15, take the Tropicana Ave. East exit; very short drive until you get to the Strip & the MGM. The MGM parking ramps can be entered from either Tropicana Avenue or Koval Lane. Koval runs N-S (as does the Strip) & is the street behind the MGM.

Desert Sky Pavilion

Typical pavilion with welded down reserved seats in front, lawn in back, large video screens and good views from just about everywhere. They usually have about 5 rows of folding chairs right in front of the stage. The entire seated area is covered by a roof, which keeps off the rain and the sun. The sides are open, to allow the hot desert breezes to blow through. Daytime temperatures are still in the 90s in Oct. If you arrive early, use sunscreen and bring water. The sun won't go down until just around showtime and people die of sun stroke every day out and it's easy to become dehydrated. You can bring water into the pavilion if it's in a sealed container. Temperatures can drop sharply when the sun goes down, so bring a light jacket. They generally don't allow lawn chairs, but they usually allow blankets on the lawn. One half mile N of the I-10 Freeway on the SE corner of 83rd Ave and Encanto Blvd. The venue is way out on the far end of town and public transportation is limited and unreliable. Driving from Phoenix

and the metro area, take I-10 westwards Los Angeles. Many people don't realize that there are actually three exits off the I-10 freeway that allow you to get into the venue. The main crowd get off on 83rd Ave, which is the furthest exit W. Go one mile N on 83rd Ave and you can't miss the huge neon sign on your right for the W parking lots. You can also exit at 75th Ave. Go one mile N to Encanto Blvd, then turn left to 79th Ave to get to the east parking lots. There's a 79th Ave HOV exit (High Occupancy Vehicle) on the left side of the freeway, in the center median between 75th and 83rd Avenues. This ramp takes you straight north up 79th Ave and to the venue, which is between 79th and 83rd Aves. Phoenix HOV lanes only require 2 passengers in the car between 6am to 6pm on weekdays. The HOV lanes can be used by anyone on weekends. Leaving: Since the 79th Ave HOV ramp is in the center median, after the show DPS usually opens it up in the opposite direction (heading east, back to Phoenix) so that traffic moves a bit more quickly. If you parked in the E lots try to get back onto 79th Ave S (make a right).

Brand new venue. Parking lots open 2 hours prior to show time. (Parking fee included in ticket price.) Weather can be iffy in Oct., usually windy, similar to San Francisco. Wear layers to be prepared. South of the airport, off I-25 at the Rio Bravo Exit. From points North, East and West: Take I-25 South from downtown Albuquerque to 3 easy exits: 1. Exit 222 B (Gibson) West, turn left on Broadway, go 4 miles, turn left on Bobby Foster Rd. 2. Exit 220 (Rio Bravo) West, turn left on Broadway, go 2 miles, turn left on Bobby Foster Rd. 3. Exit 215 (Broadway NM 47) North, go approximately 2 1/2 miles and turn right on Bobby Foster Rd. From points South of Albuquerque: Take I-25 North, Exit 215 (Broadway NM 47) North, go approximately 2 1/2 miles and turn right on Bobby Foster Rd.
